

Shoot for a Cure to benefit the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation June 5th – 6th, 2009 • New Pioneer Gun Club

Shoot for a Cure is a clay target-shooting event to benefit the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. In the first two years, *Shoot for a Cure* has raised over \$87,000 and has attracted over 250 participants with a variety of local and nationwide sponsors, supporters and volunteers. Our goal for 2009 is to raise \$55,000 for Cystic Fibrosis research and help improve the care and the lives of Iowans and of over 30,000 Americans that are faced with this devastating disease.

This year, the event will kick-off on Friday, June 5th with a VIP, 100 – target sporting clays tournament, and open target practice on the skeet, trap and 5-stand fields. Some of Iowa's premier shooters will be available for pointers and will be auctioned to join the VIP teams. Friday night will be followed by dinner, silent and live auctions and entertainment. On Saturday, June 6th a 50 – target youth trap shoot, and a 100 – target sporting clays shoot will be held in the morning and afternoon.
